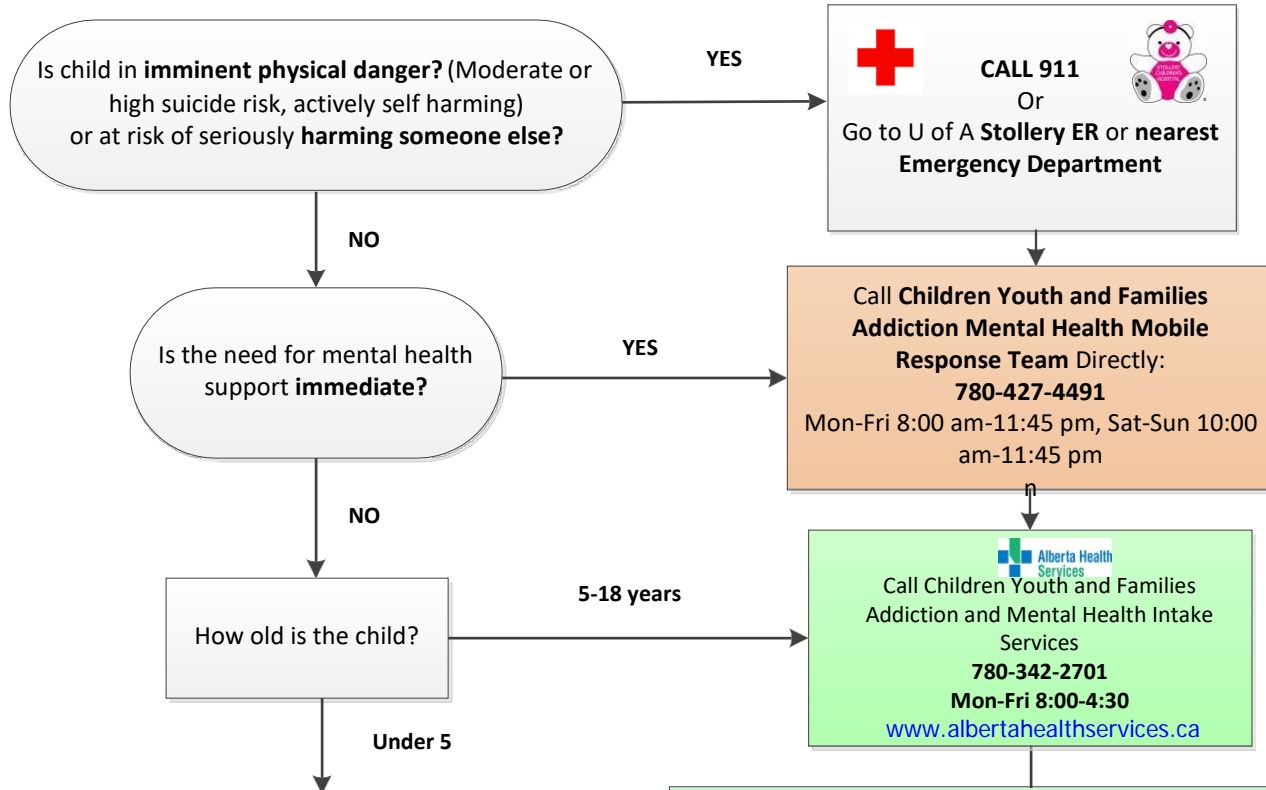


Accessing Child and Adolescent Mental Health Services in Edmonton and Area



-Families may call Children Youth and Families Addiction and Mental Health (CYFMH) Intake Services directly. CYFMH Intake Services will schedule a telephone interview between the child's legal guardian and an intake therapist.

-After the interview, service recommendations will be made — possible service provider options: Northgate clinics, CASA, Glenrose Hospital, Physicians, Psychiatrists.

-CYFMH Intake Services will forward the family's information to service provider

-Service provider will contact the family to set up an appointment

CYFMH Intake Service Location: Northgate Centre Room 2020, East end 9499 137 Avenue

For children 5-17 years, CASA services **must** be accessed through **CYFMH Intake Services**, though CAMP and FASTRACS can be referred to directly.
Average wait time for first appointment @ CASA School Age Services: 2-6 months

-Family will be offered an assessment appointment to determine appropriate treatment

-Average wait time for first appointment varies and can be up to 6-8 months

-No previous mental health assessment required
-No referral from physician/therapist required
